## THE PAPAL VISIT – PARISH YOUTH REPRESENTATIVE

On Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> September as part of his Papal visit, the Pope will meet a group of about 2,800 young people in London. It is hoped that 1 young person aged 16-20, from every parish in the country will be able to attend. They will hear his address to them and go on to occupy a good vantage point for the evening vigil which will be attended by thousands more people.
